- Completed online application for BA in Education: Multicultural Emphasis Program
- Completion of an Associate of Arts Degree in Education or Early Childhood **preferred, but not required.**
- Unofficial transcripts or copies of all college coursework. (Original transcripts will be required once accepted into the program).
- Current Navajo Nation **and** New Mexico background checks (as soon as possible)
- Fingerprint Clearance Card (as soon as possible)
- Cumulative G.P.A of 2.5 or higher at the junior level

NOTE: Applications from individuals who hold an A.A. in Education from another institution or from Diné College prior to Fall 2009, or an A.A. in a different academic specialization, are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. These individuals may need to take additional program courses.
